## MONTHLY SAFETY STATEMENT: **SAFE JOBS ARE NO ACCIDENT.**

### FENTANYL THE INVISIBLE KILLER

Drugs may contain deadly level of fentanyl. You cannot see, taste, or smell it. It is almost impossible to tell if a drug is laced with fentanyl unless tested with a fentanyl testing strip.

Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid that is 50-100 times more potent than morphine, often lethal with as little as 2 milligrams.

**one pill kills**  
don't make a deadly decision

This small amount is a **LETHAL** dose of fentanyl

**99%** of fentanyl overdoses are accidents.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK SOMEONE IS OVERDOSING:  
It may be hard to tell whether a person is high or experiencing an overdose. If you aren't sure, it's best to treat the situation like an overdose—you could save a life.

- 1 Call 911 immediately.
- 2 Administer Naloxone or Narcan, if available.
- 3 Try to keep the person awake and breathing.
- 4 Lay the person on their side to prevent choking.
- 5 Stay with them until emergency workers arrive.

**LETHAL DOSE**

The DEA lab testing reveals that 4 out of 10 pills with fentanyl, contain a potentially lethal dose
