## MONTHLY SAFETY STATEMENT: *WORK SMART, WORK SAFE*

### KEEP YOUR JOBSITE CLEAN, SAFE, AND PRODUCTIVE

Construction jobsites can be dangerous places. Equipment, workers, and contractors all moving in different directions — combined with misplaced tools, scrap metal and wood, oily rags, and other materials — can create a hazardous environment.

To reduce the risk of injuries and illnesses, pitch in throughout the day:

- ✓ Keep work areas, passageways, and stairs unobstructed.
- ✓ Remove combustible scrap and debris from the jobsite at regular intervals.
- ✓ Collect and separate waste materials, using containers provided.
- ✓ Frequently dispose of garbage and other refuse.




